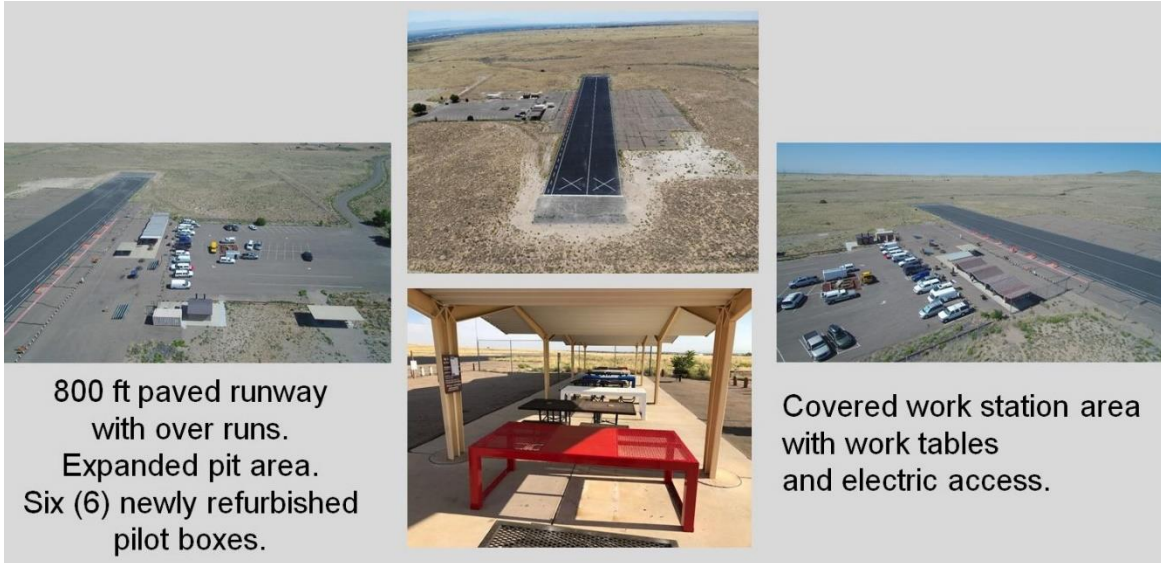


High Desert Jet Fly-In

ARCC High Desert Jet Fly-in Pilot Requirements:

- Current AMA membership. Aircraft registered with FAA.
- You have the appropriate experience to participate or will be assisted by experienced participant.
- All aircraft and control systems must have flown successfully prior to this event.
- All maneuvers to be performed by the pilot must have been successfully completed prior to this event.
- If flying an aircraft with a **gas turbine engine**, the pilot possesses a current AMA Turbine Waiver.
- If you will be buddy-box flying a gas turbine engine aircraft with an instructor, the instructor must meet the current requirements of an experienced turbine pilot as outlined in the AMA Turbine Pilot program.
- If you are flying an aircraft that weighs more than 55 pounds, you must possess the required **permit to fly** for that specific aircraft.
- By signing the **Flight Safety Declaration**, at the event, you are confirming that have read, understand, and agree to these requirements.
